

EMERGENCY ORDER NO. 10-2020

ISSUED BY THE TOWN ADMINISTRATOR

On March 13, 2020, the Town Administrator for the Town of Parker did issue an Order Declaring a Local Disaster Emergency in and for the Town of Parker (the "Emergency Declaration Order"). The Emergency Declaration Order is to be in effect until March 20, 2020, and consent has been obtained by the Parker Town Council to extend the Emergency Declaration Order to such time as the Town Administrator shall determine, in her discretion.

Pursuant to Section 15.14 of the Parker Town Charter, the Town Administrator shall assume the authority to execute any action necessary for the protection of life and property. Such authority may include but not be limited to establishing regulations governing conduct and activities related to the cause of the emergency.

The purpose of this Emergency Order No. 10-2020 is to amend Section 7.02.080 of the Parker Municipal Code concerning large vehicle parking.

Subsection (b) of Section 7.02.080 of the Parker Municipal Code, entitled Large Vehicle Parking, is hereby amended with the addition of the following (noted in underlining):

(b) It shall be unlawful for any person:

(1) To park or allow to be parked any truck-tractor, semitrailer, trailer or recreational vehicle in or upon any public street or highway in the Town, except as provided in Subsections (2) and (3) below.

(2) To park or allow to be parked a vehicle exceeding six thousand (6,000) pounds empty weight or twenty-two (22) feet in length, an automobile trailer and/or boat trailer not attached to a licensed vehicle, a truck-tractor or semitrailer, for a period of time longer than forty-eight (48) hours during any given week upon any public street located entirely within a zoned residential area; except where such vehicles are actively engaged in rendering services in the immediate area.

(3) To park or allow to be parked a truck containing an attached camper with a combined overall length exceeding twenty-two (22) feet, a recreation vehicle exceeding twenty-two (22) feet in length, or an automobile trailer and/or boat trailer attached to a licensed vehicle, for a period of time longer than forty-eight (48) hours during any given week upon any public street located entirely within a zoned residential area; except where such vehicles are actively engaged in rendering services in the immediate area or except where such camper or recreation vehicle are providing a shelter in which to self-isolate or self-quarantine during a pandemic identified in an order by the Town Administrator declaring a local disaster emergency.

This Emergency Order No. 10-2020 shall be effective on April 7, 2020, and shall remain in effect through the duration of the Order Declaring a Local Disaster Emergency, or until it is terminated or amended by the Town Administrator or until December 31, 2020, whichever is sooner.
